October 6, 1920 - September 25, 2015

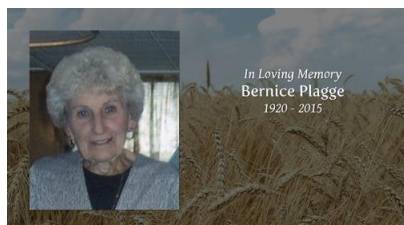
