Dennis Oliver Claus, born November 23, 1944, passed away peacefully at the age of 80 on February 20, 2025. He was a loving husband, father, and grandfather who led a life full of service, passion, and dedication to both his family and his community.

Dennis began his career as a barber, serving his clients with care and skill before being drafted into the Vietnam War. As a crew chief of a helicopter airship, he served his country with honor and pride and was recently recognized through Honor Flight Chicago this past August. After returning home from Vietnam, he worked as a truck driver for Airgas, where he became well-known for his reliability and hard work.

Dennis had a lifelong love for sports, particularly the Chicago White Sox and Chicago Bears. His passion for these teams never wavered. He also enjoyed playing golf and treasured the time spent vacationing with his family.

A dedicated volunteer, Dennis served as the Commander of the AMVETs and was deeply involved in supporting veterans. He was an active volunteer at the Veterans Home in Manteno, where his compassion and commitment to fellow veterans left a lasting impact. Dennis also spent time volunteering at the Beecher Fire Department and Beecher's Sportsman Club, further demonstrating his commitment to his community.

Dennis is survived by his loving wife, Pat Claus, children, Brian (Mindi) Claus and Lisa (Robert) Gemo, grandchildren, Madison and Shelby Gemo, sister-in-law, Crystal Claus and many other family and friends who will forever

remember him for his kindness, loyalty, and love for life.

Dennis is preceded in death by his father, Oliver Claus, his mother, Florence Claus, and his brothers, Lyle and Redgie Claus.

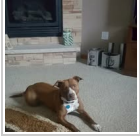
