On March 30, 1947, she publicly confessed her faith and was confirmed at Immanuel Lutheran Church Matteson, IL. with her given Scripture verse being Hebrews 13:5, "Be content with such things as you have. For He hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee" The family farm was where Ella spent her childhood. At age 16 she went to work at the Federal Reserve Bank in Chicago. 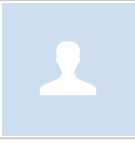
