April 5, 1933 - June 14, 2014

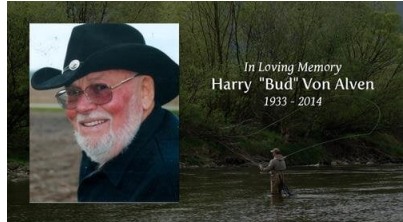
