March 17, 1938 - October 25, 2015

Lillian May Moreland, age 77, of Crete, Illinois, died at 7:27am Sunday October 25, 2015, at Franciscan St. James Health Olympia Fields, from Alzheimer's. She was born March 17, 1938, to the late Lawrence Joseph and Goldie May (nee Nusbaum) Weigel in Chicago, Illinois. Jack and Lillian (nee Weigel) were married on June 3, 1955. Lillian was raised on Chicago's south side and attended Immanuel Lutheran School and Chicago Vocational High School (CVS), where she was a pom pom girl. Lillian and Jack were in the same classes since third grade while they attended Immanuel Lutheran School. She was a devoted wife and cherished mother. Prior to moving to Crete, Illinois, in 1996, Lillian and her family lived in Dolton for thirty years where she was very active in her children's school and volunteered much of her time, including acting as President of the PTA. She was an outstanding artist and excelled in the area of sketching although she never performed professionally. Lillian was a Star Wars, Wizard of Oz, and Law & Order enthusiast; and collected memorabilia as well as glassware from different eras. She was a movie buff and followed the entertainment industry. Lillian crocheted, was a sun goddess and passionate baker; known for her pistachio cake. She was also a White Sox fan and enjoyed fishing. Lillian was an active voter, volunteered as a polling judge, and was a devout Lutheran including serving in a leadership role for many years with the youth league. Lillian had an extraordinary sense of humor and enjoyed a good party. Jack and Lillian Lil were lovers and partners for life, knowing each other for 70 years. He often referred to Lil as his beautiful Elizabeth Taylor and his beautiful rose. She is survived by her loving husband, John Jack Ernest Moreland of Crete, Illinois.
