### Obituary

Linda Kay Martens, age 63, of Grant Park, passed suddenly on the morning of July 2nd, 2019 at her home in Grant Park.

She is survived by her eldest sister, Carol Baugh, sister, Gloria Martens, her Nephew David Baugh, his wife Heather, and her Great-Nephews Michael and William; all of whom love her very much and will feel her loss deeply.
