



## Minnie L Pfingsten

May 26, 1920 - April 12, 2025

Minnie was born on May 26, 1920, and peacefully passed away on April 12, 2025, surrounded by her family. She was one of five kids who walked multiple miles to school each day carrying their lunch pails, milked the three cows, and—while they didn't have “real toys”—entertained themselves with their sleds. In her early years, she traveled to California, New York City, and the World's Fair. Her claim to fame was her three appearances as a dancer on The Lawrence Welk Show. She was 17 when she began working as a nurse at St. James Hospital and found her calling in caring for others. In 1950, she met and married the love of her life, Elmer. Together, they had five kids, who gave them 11 grandkids and 11 great-grandkids. Minnie enjoyed dressing the girls in their dresses and polished shoes to have dinner as a family. Life in the Pfingsten house was never boring with the farm, the five kids, and Minnie's menagerie of rescued and adopted

animals, including cats, dogs, goats, birds, rabbits, and pigs.

As Minnie and Elmer grew older, they braved the elements to watch local grandkids at

sporting events. They treasured moments spent celebrating holidays, birthdays, and

special occasions. They carved out time for family that was farther away and made many

trips to warmer locations like Texas, California, and one of her favorite places, the Virgin

Islands.

Minnie played cards with her sisters for many years, and as the years went on, she

introduced her kids, grandkids, and great grandkids to the game Phase 10.

She would

shake her finger at you when you had a good hand and then encourage you to “stick it to

’em” when someone else was in the lead.

Minnie had a very sentimental side, keeping cards, tickets, programs, kids’ art projects,

and other meaningful things that reminded her of those she loved. She had a unique way

of helping each person, she connected with feel heard, understood, and loved.

She loved flowers, gardening, birds, and the color pink. She also got to witness her

favorite sports team, the Chicago Cubs, win the World Series! She couldn’t get enough

family time and spent countless hours baking throughout the year. The most special

tradition was her famous Christmas brunch with no fewer than 20 different kinds of

pastries and cookies. Her most famous sugar cookies were so thin there was “nowhere

for the flavor to hide,” according to her grandsons.

When Minnie lost Elmer, she continued to attend her great grandkids’ performances and

sporting events—and this past year, even attended her very first cheer competition!

In her later years, people marveled at her extraordinary memory, her “with-it” factor, and

her ability to navigate the world of iPads and social media. Her motto was, “If you don’t

keep up with the times, they will leave you behind!”

Minnie is preceded in death by her husband, Elmer, and her grandson, Morgan Steigely. She

will be deeply missed by her children, Paulette Meiner (Donald), Patti Bernhard (David),

Pamela Spong (Michael), Penny Pfingsten, and Robert Pfingsten Sr. (Jedie), and by her

10 grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren.
