Richard Lee Tanis 80, Matteson, IL died Wednesday, September 16, 2020. Richard was born November 19th, 1939 in Grand Rapids, MI to Charles and Jessie Tanis. Richard married Roxanna Stath on June 17, 1972.

He was a pro golfer and golf professional, and owner of Custom Clubs by Tanis.

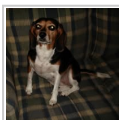
