Richard H Wehling, 81 of Beecher, IL died at St. James Hospital, Chicago Heights on Sunday, Dec. 20, 2015. Richard was born in Beecher, the son of Edwin and Lydia Stoeven Wehling on May 16, 1934. He married Beverly Nottorf on Sept. 11, 1954. Richard was a devoted Christian and a lifelong member of Zion Lutheran church where he served as a trustee.
