Robert (Bob) Bruns, a lifelong resident of Crete, lost his battle with cancer on April 16, 2021.

Bob was born at St. James Hospital in Chicago Heights, IL on November 21, 1951, to Wayne (Bruno) and Patricia (Pat) (Exo) Bruns. He was the 1st of 8 children and served in the United States Air Force. He worked on the Milwaukee Railroad and Indiana Harbor Belt.
