Vernon James Wiggenhauser, 77, from Sayner, WI died on Saturday July 18, 2020.

He was born on June 22, 1943 in Beecher, Illinois to LaVern and Vera Wiggenhauser. He graduated from Beecher High School in 1961 and went to work in a Chemical Plant nearby and attended community college at night. From there he joined the US Army for two years. He graduated from the University of Idaho in 1971 with a Forestry Management degree and was a member of the Phi Kappa Tau fraternity.
