Wynnette "Pam" Berger, age 73, born on April 21, 1952, in Chicago, IL, passed away after a courageous battle with cancer, surrounded by the love of her large and devoted family. She was a devoted wife of over forty years, a proud mother, and a beloved granny to many.

Her playful spirit was contagious - she could turn any situation into an adventure, always finding ways to bring excitement and happiness to those around her. She lived fully, loved fiercely, and left behind a legacy of laughter, warmth, and the unstoppable energy of a life well-lived.

Pam was the founder and strongest supporter of Chasing Cans for Cancer, a cause she created and championed long through before her own illness. Known far and wide as the "rodeo granny," she mothered and mentored many young riders through the Illinois High School and Junior High Rodeo circuits. She is survived by her loving husband, William Berger; her brother William Hansen and his wife Barbara; and her beloved fur baby, Dolly Berger.
